

# About this guide




This guide is from the Greens.




We are a large political party in Australia.

Parliament is where we make laws.





- a big white paper.




Ballot papers are where you show who you want to vote for.




You can help to choose the Greens to be part of parliament when you vote.

# Vote for the Greens in the House of Representatives




## Step 1

Get the small green paper.




## Step 2

Write the number 1 in the box next to the Greens name.




## Step 3


### Step 3

When you have filled out the 2 ballot papers, you need to put them in a ballot box.




There are 2 ballot boxes:

The Greens want to do a good job.




We want all people to have equal rights and be included.

We will protect the animals and the environment.




We will make sure programs like the National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) have enough money and staff to look after people.




We will make sure people can get the health care they need like dental care and mental health through Medicare.

We will help schools include disabled students and teach everyone better.




We will make more jobs available to disabled people.




We will help workplaces treat disabled people better.


